Resident Information

Board Elections- All positions will be open for the election at our Spring Meeting- President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer. Only those members whose dues are paid for the current fiscal year are eligible to vote and run. Only a single vote per individual household is allowed. For those interested, we will ask that you provide a short (2 minute limit) introduction of yourself, to our residents.

Dogs- Dogs are not allowed to run off-leash outside at any time and must be secured with a proper leash fit for the dog's size. A dog is not considered "at large" if it is, under the owner's control, on the owner's property, on private property with permission or in a car. Our Park is not a dog park and requires all dogs to be leashed.

Please pick up after your pets. The code states that owners or persons having custody of dogs or other domesticated animals shall be responsible for the clean up and removal of any feces deposited by the animal.

Rain Catch Basins- We appreciate everyone who maintains the catch basins and gutters near their properties, to make sure they stay free of debris during/after rain/snow storms.

Theft/Safety- Please utilize your porch lights at night, lock your cars and do not leave anything of value in them. If you see someone or something suspicious, contact the authorities immediately

Evergreen- Our residents receive a discounted rate with Evergreen Waste Service. Our cost is \$87 per quarter for Trash & Recycling or \$102 per quarter for Trash, Recycling and Yard Waste. Normal Evergreen rates are \$105 and \$120 respectively.
